



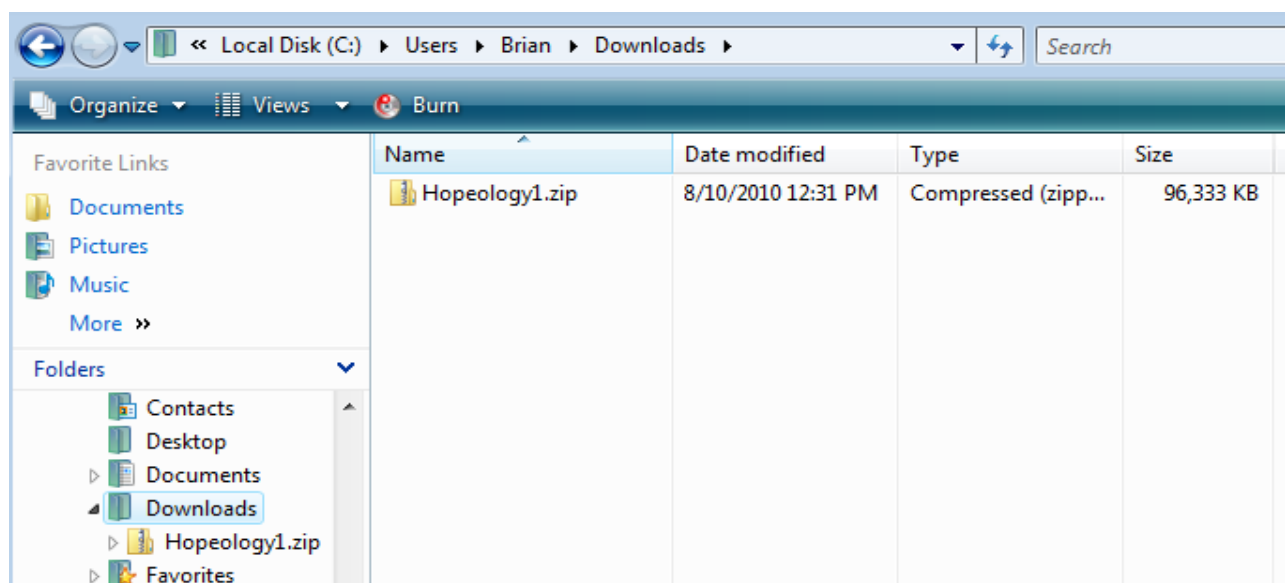
Hopeology Downloading Instructions

When you purchase a Hopeology product, you will receive a "zip" file archive. It will ask you to open it or save it. You will need to save the "zip" file. Once you've downloaded the zip file and saved it, you will also need to extract it. Here are some instructions to assist you with getting to the extracted files that you can load into your iTunes or Windows Media Player programs.

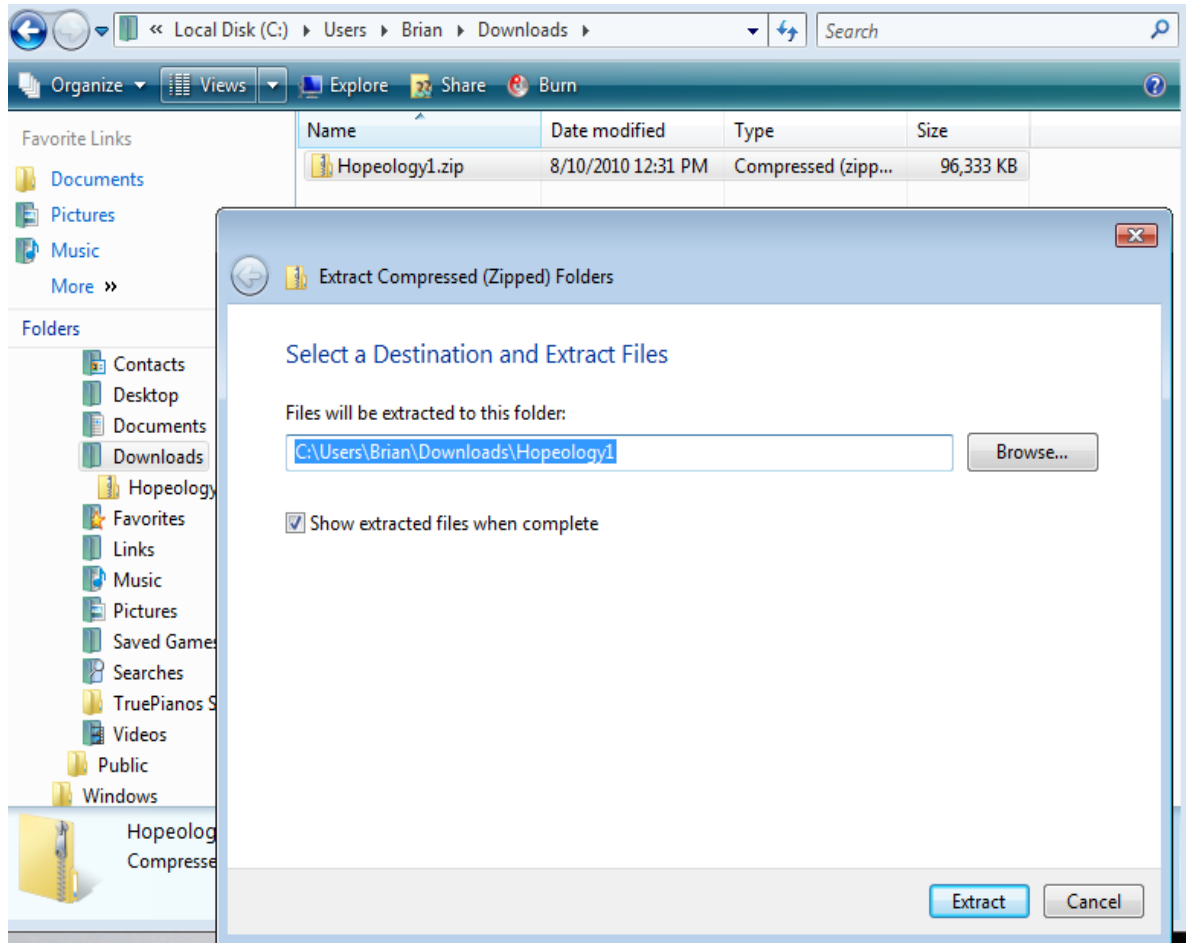
Windows

In addition to being able to extract the files, Microsoft Windows (XP and later) have the ability to browse through the zip file contents. This can be a bit confusing so you need to be sure to extract the files.

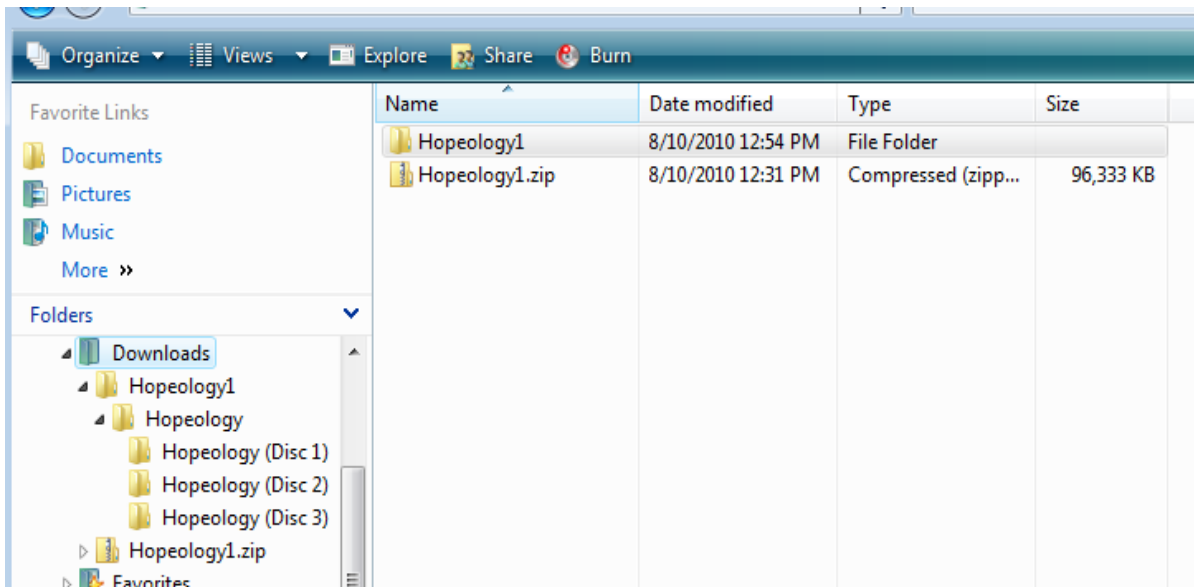
After you have downloaded and saved the "zip" file, you will see something like this (Vista shown here). The important thing to note is that there is just the "Hopeology1.zip" file in this folder.



If you right-click on the "Hopeology1.zip" file and select the "Extract All..." menu option, you will be able to select where the files are to be extracted.



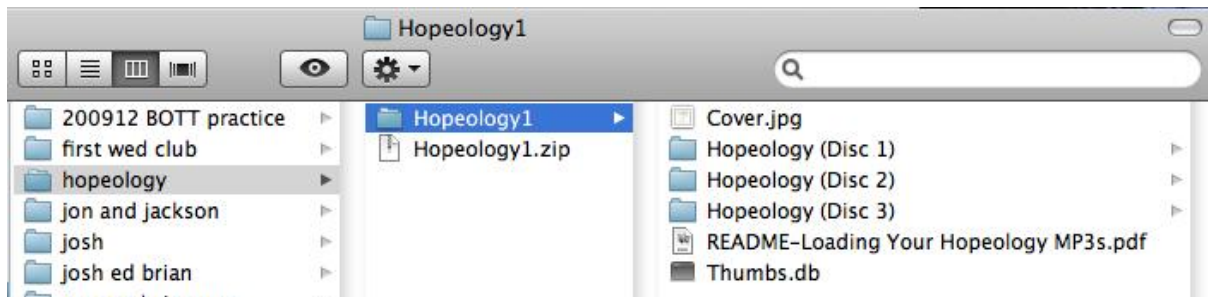
Once you've completed the extraction, you will see something like this:



Note that the "Hopeology1.zip" extraction has created the "Hopeology1" folder here. Now you're ready to take the "README-Loading Your Hopeology MP3s.pdf" file and begin loading the audio files into iTunes and/or Windows Media Player.

Macintosh

Once you've downloaded the zip file to your Mac, just double-click the zip file and it will be automatically extracted. You will then see something like this:



Note that the "Hopeology1.zip" extraction has created the "Hopeology1" folder here. Now you're ready to take the "README-Loading Your Hopeology MP3s.pdf" file and begin loading the audio files into iTunes.
